Choirs In Special Program Sunday

VOLPE PROPOSES MBTA CAR YARD IN MILTON

Butler Street Site May Ire Residents

Governor John A. Volpe has announced his intentions of filing a special message with the Legislature which will call for the construction of marshaling yard for MBTA cars in Milton in order to expedite construction of the John F. Kennedy Memorial Library in Cambridge.

The proposal, which is certain to ire many Milton residents to the same degree that it has stirred selectmen Francis F. Brooks, calls for the MBTA "car yard" for storage and repair to be located on the Butler street marshes. Such a move would make it possible for the State to move towards construction of the Kennedy Library at the MBTA Bennett street yards in Cambridge.

The original proposal along these lines called for the new marshaling area to be located along the same Mattapan-Ashmont line but nearer to the Cedar Grove area. This venture was stopped in its inception by an outraged Dorchester population which forced passing of legislation to prohibit the construction of such a facility with the area of a hospital, in this case the Carney Hospital.

Gov. Volpe says he talked the entire matter over with Senator Edward Kennedy and that the senior senator from the Bay State expressed a hopefulness that the matter could be resolved as rapidly as possible.

Dorchester residents did not stand still for the construction of the "car yard" in their district. And, it is a question whether or not Miltonites are willing to sit by and allow the facility to be constructed in the Butler street area.

Chairman Brooks has declared, "We understand preparation for the site will cost in excess of \$1 million. A good portion of the location is marshy land, and from time to time at high tide, is flooded. This will mean increased expenses, Milton is paying a substantial deficit for service which touches only the western

border of the town." Earlier in the year Milton selectmen vowed total opposition to the plans for the yard being switched from the Dorchester area to the Butler street site.

Brooks said his board has notified the local representa-

tives of their opposition to the plan. Expectation is that such a yard will require a large parking lot and there is fear that the MBTA will want to build a road from Granite avenue which would only serve to increase the present traffic problem.
